Dear Robbie Williams fan,

We would like you to carefully read the following so we can make sure that everyone will enjoy the show and we do not face delays at the entrance.

FORBIDDEN

For safety reasons it is forbidden to bring glass bottles, cans, hard packaging or any objects that may be used as a throwing device (deoderant, perfume,...) to the venue. Therefore these items will be collecting at the entrance point.

Furthermore it is not allowed to bring professional cameras such as reflex cameras, cameras with zoom objectives and/or the function to videotape, professional digital cameras, any recording device or laserpointers.

Bags shall be DIN A4 (21cm x 29,7cm) or smaller!

So please leave the following items at home in ordert o quicken the security check:

- backpacks, big bags or suitcases
- professional cameras with an interchangeable lens
- audio and videotaping devices
- GoPro cameras
- selfie sticks
- electronic devices such as tablets, laptops, powerbanks etc.
- Food and alcoholic drinks. 1 non alcoholic drink 0,5l max per person in tetra containment or PET plastic bottle is allowed.

- chairs
- weapons, knives, taser, batons, pepperspray,...
- torches, glowsticks, chains, laserpointer
- big flags and posters (incl. sticks)
- helmets
- big umbrellas

MISCELLANEOUS

Refreshment stations with a big diversity of different drinks and food can be found at the venue. It's not permitted to bring food and any kind of drinks inside the Olympiastadion.

Don't forget to protect yourself from the sun (sunblock in travel size, hats, etc) and to bring rainproof clothing.

Loud music may damage your ears! Please be reminded that ear protection is really important, especially for children. We advise you not to bring children under 8 to the show.

Medical staff will be present on site for any emergencies.

TRAVEL

We advise you to use local public transportation, the 4.000 available parking lots are usually occupied in the afternoon. Especially for visitors travelling to Munich from outside, we recommend the Park&Ride options available all around Munich.

1. LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Subway Line U3, via „Olympiazentrum“

Around 10 minutes walking distance to Olympiapark

Tram line 20 and 21 to „Olympiapark West“ station

Tram line 27 to „Petuelring“ station

City bus stop 173 to „Olympiazentrum“

City bus stop 144 to „Spiridon-Louis-Ring“

City bus stop 173, 177 and 178 to „Petuelring“

2. CAR

Attention Emission Zone – Parking area „Parkharfe“ free!

The middle ring of the inner city is not a green zone. Thus, visitors of Olympiapark can drive directly from the central ring („Landshuter Allee“) via „Sapporobogen“ to the „Parkharfe“ parking area – without a special emission badge.

Parking fares for passenger cars:
Parkharfe: 5,00 € / day

From Berlin / Nuremberg via A9 motorway:

Follow the motorway until the very end, exit at „Mittlerer Ring West“, continue in the direction of „Olympia Park“ until the underpass at „Lerchenauer Street“ (next to the BMW museum), then change to the lane on the far right side. To access the parking area, please turn right at „Olympiahalle“.

From Deggendorf via A92 motorway:

Follow the motorway until the very end, exit at „Mittlerer Ring West“, continue in the direction of „Olympia Park“ until the underpass at „Lerchenauer Street“ (next to the BMW museum), then change to the lane on the far right side. To access the parking area, please turn right at „Olympiahalle“.

From Passau via A94 motorway:

Take the motorway until „München Ost“ junction, follow in the direction of „Nürnberg“ until you reach „München Nord“ junction, then continue in the direction of „München“ until the end of the motorway. Exit at „Mittlerer Ring West“, continue in the direction of „Olympia Park“ until the underpass at „Lerchenauer Street“ (next to the BMW museum), then change to the lane on the far right side. To access the parking area, please turn right at „Olympiahalle“.

From Salzburg / Innsbruck via A8 motorway:

Follow the motorway until „Ramersdorf“ (do not take the A99 motorway via Giesing!), turn right in the direction of „Olympiapark“. Follow sign posts on the middle ring („Mittlerer Ring“) to „Olympiapark / Autobahn Nürnberg“ until you reach the underpass at „Lerchenauer Street“ (next to the BMW museum). Change to the lane on the far right side. To access the parking area, please turn right at „Olympiahalle“.

From Garmisch-Partenkirchen via A95 motorway:

Follow the motorway until „Luise-Kieselbach-Platz“, turn half left to the middle ring („Mittlerer Ring“) in the direction of „Olympiapark“. Access to the parking lot at the former velodrome.

From Lindau via A96 motorway:

Follow the motorway until the very end at „Mittlerer Ring Nord“, follow the middle ring („Mittlerer Ring“) in the direction of „Olympiapark“. Access to the parking lot at the former velodrome.

From Stuttgart via A8 motorway:

Follow the motorway until the very end, continue straight and follow the „Verdistr.“ (the street later continues as „Amalienburgstr.“, then „Menzingerstr.“) until

„Wintrichring“, turn left in the direction of „Olympiapark / Autobahn Nürnberg“. The street expands to four lanes at „Georg-Brauchle-Ring“ close to the Olympiapark area.

3. PARKEN

Attention Emission Zone – Parking area „Parkharfe“ free!

The middle ring of the inner city is not a green zone. Thus, visitors of Olympiapark can drive directly from the central ring („Landshuterallee“) via „Sapporobogen“ to the „Parkharfe“ parking area – without a special emission badge.

Parking at Olympiaturm and Parking lot at Olympia-Eissportzentrum:

Up to 30 minutes: free

2 hours: 4,00 €

3 hours: 5,00 €

4 hours: 6,00 €

5 hours: 7,00 €

6 hours: 8,00 €

whole day: 12,00 €

From south west via small Marathontor.

Handicapped parking at Olympiapark:

- Parking level at Olympiaturm (5 minutes to Olympiahalle entrance east)
6 lots
- Parkharfe at Olympiastadion
20 lots Block 1
- Parking lot at Olympia-Eissportzentrum
3 lots

Toilets for Wheelchair users:

- 2 toilets: at the small Marathontor
- 1 toilet: at Block M
